

Paul Emory grew up in a small mining/ farming town west of Zanesville, White Cottage. He transferred to Ringling College of Art and Design in Florida. Upon receiving a BFA in 1981 he moved to NYC where he was accepted to get his masters at Pratt Institute. After 7 months in Brooklyn and out money he enlisted in the army. For the next two years while based in Manheim, Germany he visited museums all over Europe whenever he

got time off. After returning to the USA he completed his masters at OU in Athens in 1989. Returning to Zanesville he renovated one of his first buildings which became his studio on the corner of 5th and Main, which is now demolished. In the last years, his efforts have been in preserving the 600 block which is getting to be known as "the Old Quarter."
